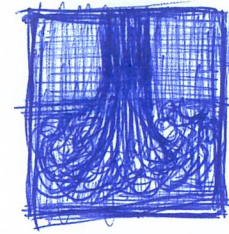


Those Left Behind - first attempt on breaking down the environment

The Outback

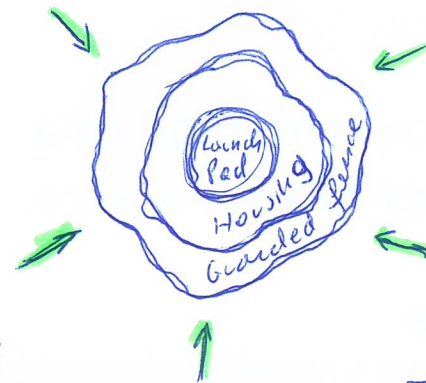
desolate remains of once lush and populated Earth, barren and dangerous plains, dead forests, dried-up lakes, rivers of acid and radiating mountains

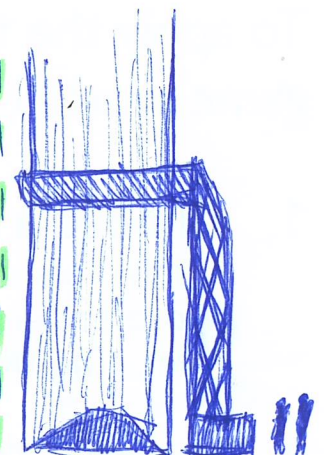
Guarded fence

Intermittent housing

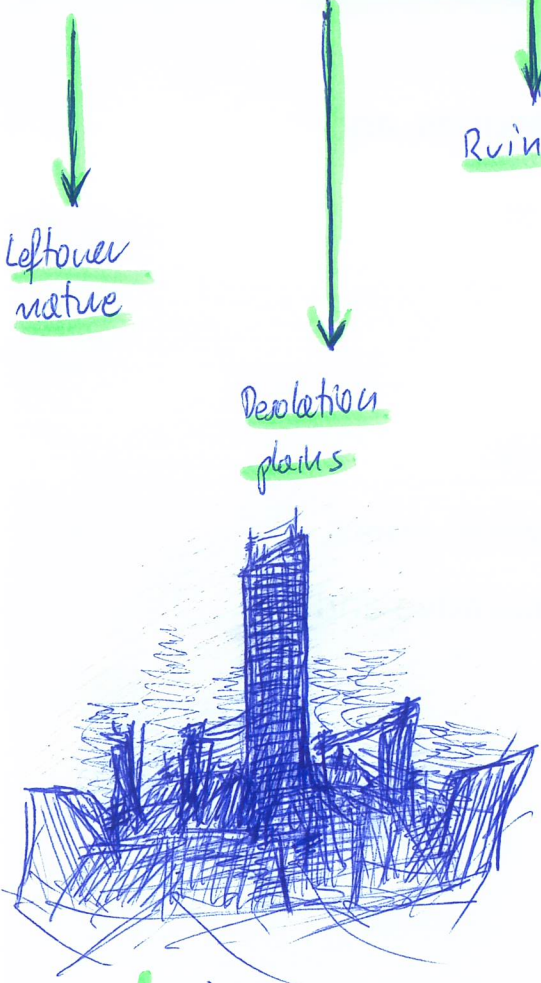
- clean, compact, necessary luxury
